

# Relief Offering 2020 Projects

## *My Father's House -- Oregon*

My Father's House is a local organization that we have partnered with for many years. They are a family centered shelter that focuses on getting people back on their feet. Currently, they are working to build a facility that will serve as a thrift store and coffee shop to provide job skills, training and education while also providing an income to those working there. This, along with their other housing program, will help to get families back into a stable and sustainable future.

Proposed amount: \$20,000

## *Mission Aviation Fellowship -- Uganda*

Dave Forney, with Mission Aviation Fellowship in Uganda, has made us aware of the need to rebuild three strategic airstrips in Uganda. These airstrips were already falling in to disrepair prior to Covid-19. With the six month flight restrictions and regular maintenance that was put on hold, they have become unusable. This has made many hard to reach regions even more difficult to access, leaving many communities even more vulnerable than usual.

Proposed amount: \$20,000

## *Together We Serve -- Thailand*

Together We Serve trains at risk young Thai men and women to become leaders by serving their communities. They train in areas such as dental hygiene education and haircutting and provide food and essential items to communities in need. Program participants go out into the community and provide services, education and supplies to help improve the health and well being of their communities.

Proposed amount: \$20,000

## *Timothy Project -- Uganda*

The Timothy Project started by Dr Val, and run by the CLIDE Consultancy, serves around 160 children and young adults in the Karamoja region in NE Uganda. It supports the educational needs of these local children providing tuition and scholastic materials, counseling and mentoring. The Timothy children are orphans due to wars and HIV/AIDS, former street children, and poor pastors' children.

Proposed amount: \$20,000
