Step-by-Step Guide


Here's all the steps to register and get fully connected to the Large group, lessons and teaching videos, and resources for Good Shepherd's Women's Bible Study 2021. We are studying the book of Philippians, a study that was written by a team of Good Shepherd women.

We encourage you to set aside some time (maybe 15-30 minutes) to log in to all the parts of the study following the steps below. We want you to get familiar with this new format, check out all the resources and videos, and get excited about studying the book of Philippians

*** Note... the process will go smoother if you use a computer or tablet for the initial logins, rather than a mobile phone.*

1. Register online with Good Shepherd.

- The link above will take you to the event details page, where you can click the green "REGISTER" button.
- The \$10 fee helps cover the cost of includes weekly lessons and teaching videos, weekly encouragement from Peri, and many other digital resources.
- On the registration login page, enter your phone number to receive a quick code by text to log in. Or if you'd prefer to use your email for the code instead, click that option (in smaller font below the NEXT button).
- Complete the registration with payment, and you'll receive an automated confirmation email with additional helpful information.

2. Gather or join a group to meet with weekly

- Studying the Bible in community is one of the most important ways to stay consistent, get the most out of the study, and grow in the Lord. If you have already identified a group of women to meet with, great!
- If you need a group to meet with, here's a few tips:
 - Contact your favorite friends and invite them to do the study and meet with you. You can share the link to **Step-by-Step Guide** so they know how to sign up!
 - In the Large Group on the Resources tab, find a helpful resource titled *Creating A Small Group*.
 - In the Large Group on the Members tab, you can view the list of ALL the women who have signed up for our study, and can email friends about meeting together or joining their group. Be sure to check back to the list every few days as more people sign up and are added to the Online Group.
- Each small group will decide how and when they want to meet: in-person groups in homes or at church (must reserve space through [Debbie Felzien](#)), or online by Zoom or other online group formats.

3. Log in to the Large Group.

- Soon after your registration, you will receive an automated email with the subject line *"You've been added to a Group!"*. Click the link in that email (or the link above) to log in to the Large Group.
- The Large Group login page will say Planning Center, that's the Good Shepherd church database where our Large Group is hosted. Click the "need password" link to get a quick code by text (or email if you choose) and set a password. Make a note of your password, though you should automatically remain logged in to the group for up to two weeks at a time. (*Tip: write your password on the inside cover of your study book for easy reference.*)
- Find all the **Resources** and **Group Members** in the Online Group!
 - To view any resource listed, scroll to the far right of the row and click "Download".
 - The Members list is a great way for you to see all the names of everyone else doing the study, and connect in small groups to meet up (in person or by video) with friends to discuss it together. You can click an email to anyone else in the group from the Members page.

- d. Once you have successfully logged in to the Large Group, it will be helpful to **bookmark** (or add favorite) that page in your browser for future reference. If you're not sure how to do that, there's a Resource in the Large Group to help, or you can Google search how to do it for your specific device.

4. Check your email weekly to access lessons, teaching videos, and encouragements from Peri.
