

Exploration Questions:

- What was your religious background as a child? Was your experience positive, negative, or neutral?
 - Where are you now in your spiritual journey?
 - What words would you use to describe your life spiritually?
 - Who has had the greatest impact on your life spiritually? Why?
 - Do you have a spiritual belief of any kind? - What don't you believe?
 - Have you ever experienced God? If so, how?
 - How would you describe your belief in God?
 - Has anything dramatic happened in your life that has convinced you that God is real?
 - Who is Jesus to you? Why do you think he died?
 - Where would you say you are at with God?
 - Do you find yourself moving toward God, away from God, or staying about the same? - Are you satisfied with where you are spiritually, or do you desire more?
 - What would you say is your greatest need spiritually at this time?
- If you could ask God one question, what would it be?
- If you were going to meet with God, what would you be thinking?
 - If God could ask you one question, what do you think He might ask?
 - If a friend asked you how to become a Christian, what would you tell them?
 - On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate your desire to know God personally?
 - What is most important to you? What are you living for? Why?
 - What do you think is the main point of the Bible?
 - What do you think happens when you die?
 - If you were to die tonight, how sure are you that you would experience eternal life, that is a never-ending relationship with God? Why?
 - If you were standing at the gate of heaven and God asked you, "Why should I let you into My heaven?" how would you respond? On a scale of 1-10 how confident are you that your answer would get you into heaven?
 - I try to pray for other people, is there something I could pray for you about?
