

Growth Group Lesson March 27 – 28, 2021

Title: The Servant King in Victory, Part 6: “But why” - Mark 15:33-41

Big Idea: Draw near to the one who broke the curse, fulfilled the promises, and made a way.

How did the Lord speak to you in the message this weekend?

Have you ever wondered why something is the way it is?

Why do you think there is so much brokenness and pain in the world that we live in?

Read Mark 15:33-41.

1. Jesus died to break the curse.

This passage reveals the cost of our sin; darkness and death. Why is it important to consider the cost of our sin?

What is our appropriate response when we recognize our sin?

2. Jesus died to fulfill the promises.

Read Isaiah 53.

What promises did Jesus fulfill?

3. Jesus died to make a way.

Read Mark 15:38.

What did the curtain of the temple separate?

What did the tearing of the curtain symbolize?

Jesus' was the ultimate sacrifice and opens up access to God that wasn't there before. What must we do to have this access?

Read Mark 15:39.

Why is this confession by the centurion so significant?

Read Mark 1:1. The centurion is the first one to identify Jesus' true identity in Mark's narrative. Why is it important to know who Jesus truly is?

Read Hebrews 10:19-22 & Hebrews 4:6.

In what ways do you need mercy?

In what areas of your life do you need grace to help in time of need?

Is there any reason why you don't confidently go before him?

Spend some time drawing near to the Lord in prayer.
